

1 Lesson Brainstorming

How AI can help:
Generate themes, hooks, or activity ideas

Example prompt:
Suggest a 40-minute group activity to teach theme and tone in short stories for S4 students

4 Differentiating Content

How AI can help:
Adjust reading level, simplify explanations

Example prompt:
Rewrite this article for S3 ESL learners with low reading comprehension

2 Content Creation

How AI can help:
Draft stories, dialogues, worksheets, case studies

Example prompt:
Write a sample dialogue between a doctor and patient using 5 key medical vocabulary words

5 Slides and Visuals

How AI can help:
Suggest slide outlines, generate images

Example prompt:
Create a 5-slide outline on 'How AI works' for S5 ICT

3 Language & Translation Support

How AI can help:
Translate or rephrase materials

Example prompt:
Translate this worksheet from English to Traditional Chinese for mixed-medium students

6 Ethical and Bias Review

How AI can help:
Scans materials for biased or insensitive language automatically

Example prompt:
Scan this history lesson for Eurocentric bias and outdated terminology
