1 Live Clarifications

How AI can help:

Provide instant definitions, examples, or rewordings

Example of when to use it:

When a student asks for clarification or when concepts fall flat

4 Speech-to-Text Notes & Summaries

How AI can help:

Transcribe and summarize student discussions or presentations in real time

Example of when to use it:

During group presentations or peer feedback sessions.

2 Multi-Level Support

How AI can help:

Instantly reword or adapt texts and questions to match different student ability levels during a lesson

Example of when to use it:

When students need clearer explanations, simplified content, or extra support — right in the moment, as learning happens

5 Scenario Roleplay Creator

How AI can help:

Generate realistic dialogue scripts or scenarios tailored on-the-fly

Example of when to use it:

During language classes or social-emotional learning activities

3 Idea Generator

How AI can help:

Offer creative or alternative answers for group discussion

Example of when to use it:

When brainstorming or exploring multiple perspectives

6 Adaptive Socratic Questioning

How AI can help:

Generate follow-up questions tailored to student answers to deepen thinking

Example of when to use it:

During discussions or student presentations to prompt reflection
